ICISP Canterbury, England 2025/26 AY Study Abroad Liaison

The Illinois Consortium for International Studies and Programs (ICISP) is pleased to provide a professional development opportunity for faculty members of ICISP-member institutions. Since 1994, ICISP has been working with Canterbury Christ Church University (CCCU) in Canterbury, England. This position provides faculty or staff from member institutions the opportunity to experience first-hand living and interacting with students and colleagues in an international setting.

This opportunity is contingent upon sufficient student enrollment Tentative dates are 3rd week of September & 3rd week of January

Responsibilities

The Liaison will travel with the students and stay in Canterbury for one week to assist in student transition and acclimation. Study Abroad Liaisons will be expected to fulfill the following responsibilities:

- Attend student orientation prior to program (held one Saturday in November)
- Communicate with students prior to the recommended flight about airline check-in
- Travel on the recommended flight and serve as resource for students during travel
- Assist students with the adjustment to living in a different culture
- Assist with coordination of orientation activities
- Perform administrative duties of the ICISP program as needed
- Provide advisement to students as needed
- Assist students in solving problems which arise and communicate with the ICISP coordinator

Compensation

Study Abroad Liaisons will receive compensation as follows:

- Salary Paid by home college, if applicable
- Housing Stipend provided by ICISP (up to \$1,050)
- Transportation -
 - Roundtrip economy international airfare from Chicago O'Hare to London Heathrow is paid by ICISP (up to \$1000)
 - Transportation with students from Heathrow to Canterbury is paid by ICISP
 - o Return train from Canterbury to Heathrow is paid by ICISP
 - Transportation to/from Chicago O'Hare airport is the responsibility of the Liaison
- Meals
 - Responsibility of the Liaison

Qualifications

Study Abroad Liaisons should demonstrate:

- Good interpersonal relations with students and colleagues
- Commitment to professional development
- Flexibility and ability to adapt to different cultural settings
- Travel experience preferred
